We are proud to announce our annual Lori C. Pemberton Memorial Scholarship. This \$1,000.00 scholarship is available to one talented high school senior who lives in New York City. This scholarship honors the legacy of Lori C. Pemberton, a founding board member of The Five Pearls Foundation, and a life member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Inc. Her legacy is one of commitment to service and making a positive impact on the lives of others, especially our youth. The Five Pearls Foundation is a public charity created to do its part to address ills that affect underserved communities, specifically poor health, limited access to quality education and unrealized understanding of their place in the world and the possibilities that exist for each individual.

We hope to encourage and support one young African-American, Black or Latino woman or man who:



- Is a graduating high school senior;
- Has an overall GPA of "B" or 80% and above;
- Will be attending a four year accredited College/University;
- Will be enrolled as a full-time student in the fall semester of 2010; and
- Has demonstrated her/his concern for her school and her community through volunteer service, involvement in clubs, and other associations.

The scholarship will be awarded in two parts and is to be used specifically towards academic pursuits. The student will receive \$500.00 each semester, totaling no more than \$1,000.00 for the freshman year in college. The recipient must continue full time status and be in good standing with their academic institution, or forfeit the scholarship award.

The applicant must submit a complete application, including her high school transcript and recommendations. The application will not be considered complete until all materials have been received. Once the recipient of the scholarship has been determined, she will need to provide a copy of her bursars receipt in order to receive her scholarship award.
